The dental hygiene students volunteer a combined total of over 600 hours of community service over the course of the school year. Since we are an Affiliate of the National Children's Oral Health Foundation, we educate a large population of children throughout various communities. Students participate in community outreach events where children are engaged in learning about how to take care of their teeth. Having educational puppets would be an excellent addition to the materials (puzzles, magnetic boards) that we already have. In addition, a table throw cover (8 ft convertible table throw - one color thermal imprint) would be used at every outreach event as our table covering. This would identify our program as well as Chabot College.
