The Mammoth Has Landed! Again!!

For those of you who have been following this convoluted story since its beginning in 2009, I have news. At our wonderful October, 2023 CARE get-together, I showed many of you the location in L1600 where the fossils were on display. Our understanding at the



time was that we would utilize the walls behind the display cases for our museum quality printed posters. But as can happen in the world of colleges, and life, things evolved, and administration changed their use plans for that space. Luckily for us, L2100, a brand-new building with a large central atrium, would be available.

Our team (Dan Cearley from Anthropology, me, Ann Kroll from Construction management and Steve Gunderson from IT, with support from M and O staff) was able to carefully move the fossilized front leg bones on cushioned carts. The display cases were placed on dollies, and all were conveyed carefully across campus to their new home in late March. The new location required some fine tuning, as we can not ever allow direct sun to hit and degrade the fragile fossils.

After some discussion, we created a plan where IT will provide two large monitors, one in portrait and one in landscape orientation, to allow us to show our educational materials about the history of mammoths and other megafauna in the Tri Valley. They will be placed on the wall behind the display cases, next to a busy walkway with a lot of foot traffic. Entire classes could be brought here to learn- whether it is to study the bones themselves, the graphic design skills used for the scrolling posters, or the art of our custom created oil painting of the hills with Columbian mammoths browsing.

Stay tuned.....there will be further developments.
